Im Gegensatz zu dem reichen Marchenmaterial, das wir z. B. in den Predigtexempeln finden, ist die Auswahl auf wenige bekannte Stoffe begrenzt, die hier erstmals in einer gemeinsamen funktionsgeschichtlich ideologischen Perspektive zusammen behandelt werden.

Viele Ausgaben sind in irgendeiner Form, meist für Kinder, bearbeitet. Diese Gesamtausgabe bietet die Märchen so, wie sie von den Brüdern Grimm selbst herausgegeben wurden. Dabei ist sie im doppelten Sinne konkurrenzlos: Sie umfasst zum einen nicht nur alle Märchen nach der Ausgabe letzter Hand von 1857, sondern auch alle von den Grimms dort nicht mehr aufgenommenen Märchen früherer Auflagen. Zum anderen enthält die Ausgabe auch alle Originalanmerkungen der Brüder Grimm. Ein umfangreicher Anhang bietet exakte Herkunftsnachweise zu jedem Märchen, verzeichnet alle Beiträger und Vermittler, nennt die Erscheinungsjahre der verschiedenen Märchen-Fassungen und bietet viele weitere Informationen.

Wied (1843-1916) zahlreiche literarische Werke, die Anfang des 20. Jahrhunderts weltweit ein breites Publikum fanden. Der soziale Status der Autorin trug nicht unwesentlich zu ihrer Popularität bei, denn als ‚Dichterin auf dem Thron‘ erregte sie besonderes Aufsehen. Doch genau dadurch konnte Carmen Sylva mit ihrem Schreiben, mit dem sie in großem Maße auch eine Kulturvermittlung zwischen Ost- und Westeuropa beabsichtigte, eine breitere Leserschaft erreichen. Nach ihrem Tod jedoch geriet Carmen Sylva in Vergessenheit, so wie viele andere Schriftsteller, deren Werke vom Zeitgeist des folgenden Jahrhunderts überholt wurden. Trotzdem haben einige Werke Carmen Sylvas und insbesondere ihre Pelesch-Märchen bis heute ihren Reiz noch nicht verloren, und sie erscheinen weiterhin in rumänischen Neuauflagen. Lange Zeit wurden die Pelesch-Märchen fälschlicherweise als Übertragungen rumänischer Volksmärchen ins Deutsche betrachtet. Silvia Irina Zimmermann zeigt in ihrer Studie erstmals ausführlich, dass Carmen Sylvas Märchen eigene literarische Produktionen der Schriftsteller-Königin und keine Nacherzählungen rumänischer Volksmärchen oder Sagen sind. Die Pelesch-Märchen können mit Recht als ‚kleine Kunstwerke‘ bezeichnet werden, da die Autorin in ihren Kunstmärchen auf originelle und anschauliche Weise eigene Phantasie mit übernommenen Motiven der Volksliteratur verbindet, diese gekonnt mit einer geographischen Landschaft in Verbindung bringt und den Eindruck einer mündlich tradierten Geschichte vermittelt. Der Leser wird beständig dazu gebracht, die teils märchenhaften, teils realistischen Schilderungen zu bewundern und zu bestaunen; Carmen Sylva weckt erfolgreich das Interesse für den Zauber ihres fernen Königreiches. Auch aus literarhistorischer Sicht sind die Pelesch-Märchen der Schriftsteller-Königin erwähnens- und lesenswert, denn in ihnen wird eine gelungene literarische Symbiose deutscher und rumänischer Motive der Volks- und Kunstmärchen offenbar. „Wenn die rumänische Königskrone den Dichtungen

Fairy Tales from Before Fairy Tales Jan M.

Ziolkowski.2010-02-01 When did fairy tales begin? What qualifies as a fairy tale? Is a true fairy tale oral or literary? Or is a fairy tale determined not by style but by content? To answer these and other questions, Jan M. Ziolkowski not only provides a comprehensive overview of the theoretical debates about fairy tale origins but includes an extensive discussion of the relationship of the fairy tale to both the written and oral sources. Ziolkowski offers interpretations of a sampling of the tales in order to sketch the complex connections that existed in the Middle Ages between oral folktales and their written equivalents, the variety of uses to which the writers applied the stories, and the diverse relationships between the medieval texts and the expressions of the same tales in the classic fairy tale collections of the nineteenth century. In so doing, Ziolkowski explores stories that survive in both versions associated with, on the one hand, such standards of the nineteenth-century fairy tale as the Brothers Grimm, Hans Christian Andersen, and Carlo Collodi and, on the other, medieval Latin, demonstrating that the literary fairy tale owes a great debt to the Latin literature of the medieval period.
