The Origins of the German Principalities, 1100-1350 Graham A. Loud, Jochen

Schenk. 2017-07-06 The history of medieval Germany is still rarely studied in the English-speaking world. This collection of essays by distinguished German historians examines one of the most important themes of German medieval history, the development of the local principalities. These became the dominant governmental institutions of the late medieval Reich, whose nominal monarchs needed to work with the princes if they were to possess any effective authority. Previous scholarship in English has tended to look at medieval Germany primarily in terms of the struggles and eventual decline of monarchical authority during the Salian and Staufener eras - in other words, at the failure of a centralised monarchy. Today, the federalised nature of late medieval and early modern Germany seems a more natural and understandable phenomenon than it did during previous eras when state-building appeared to be the natural and inevitable process of historical development, and any deviation from the path towards a centralised state seemed to be an aberration. In addition, by looking at the origins and consolidation of the principalities, the book also brings an English audience into contact with the modern German tradition of regional history (Landesgeschichte). These path-breaking essays open a vista into the richness and complexity of German medieval

history.

Gerhard Michalek.2016-01-25 Bereits vor etwa 950 Jahren mischten die Haunsberger bei der Machtaufteilung unter den Fürsten und Grafen zwischen Salzburg, Bayern und Österreich kräftig mit. Ausgehend von ihrem Stammsitz in St. Pankraz am Haunsberg bauten sie in dieser Region ihr Herrschaftsgebiet östlich der Salzach auf ehemals Passauer Boden auf. Die auf einem schroffen Felsvorsprung errichtete Stammburg der Hochfreien von Haunsberg in St. Pankraz am Haunsberg war Machtzentrale und Herrschaftsmittelpunkt dieses Hochadelsgeschlechts. Ihre Besitzungen trugen wesentlich zur Landeswerdung Salzburgs bei und bilden im Norden des Landes heute noch die Grenze. Den Haunsbergern gehörten sogar das Gebiet um die Stadt Linz und nördlich daran anschließend weite Teile des mittleren Mühlviertels. Nachweisbar fünf Generationen lang (etwa von 1070 bis 1215) dauerte die Blüte dieses edelfreien Geschlechts, dessen Wirken die Geschichte der Region im deutschen Südosten nachhaltig beeinflusst hat.

Galban.2020-07-29 The Council of Constance and the conclusion of the Papal Schism released long pent-up energies of reform throughout the Church and in the religious Orders in particular. The Austrian Visitation of 1418/19 which propelled Georg Muestinger to the highest position in Stift Klosterneuburg and introduced the Raudnitz Reform of canons regular into his ancient monastery, illustrates how these energies both cooperated and competed with each other to achieve a reform of religious life. The centerpiece of this work is the introduction of the Raudnitz

Statutes into the monastery and Muestinger's adaptation of that legislation.

Dynastengeschichte und Verwandtschaftsbilder Ursula Peters.2011-07-19 Die vorliegende Arbeit zur Rolle der Adelsfamilie in der volkssprachigen Literatur des Mittelalters ist als eine Art literarhistorische Erprobung einer mentalitätsgeschichtlichen Themenstellung gedacht. Als Enkel und Neffe von Kaisern, Halbbruder eines Königs, Bruder von Herzögen und eines Bischofs gehörte er zur Spitze der Gesellschaft - und ein Spitzenamt in dieser Gesellschaft sollte er nach dem Willen seiner Familie auch dereinst bekleiden. So schickte man ihn zum Studium nach Paris, damit er dort jene Techniken erwerben sollte, derer man bedurfte, wenn man die weltlichen und geistlichen Angelegenheiten der Zeit beherrschen wollte. Paris aber glich damals einem intellektuellen Laboratorium. Hier begannen die Schulen, das aus der heidnischen und christlichen Antike überlieferte Wissen systematisch zu organisieren, Curricula für Studien zu entwickeln und damit der gelehrten Arbeitsweise einer ganzen Epoche die Basis zu schaffen: dem scholastischen Denken, das im 13.und14.Jahrhundert seine größte Wirkung entfalten sollte. Unter diesen mannigfaltigen Einflüssen entwickelte sich Otto zu einer Persönlichkeit von markanter Eigenständigkeit und suchte für sich den Weg des Geistes und des Gebets in einem französischen Zisterzienserklster, bevor er als Bischof und Reichsfürst

einer der großen philosophisch-theologischen Schriftsteller des Mittelalters wurde. The Play about the Antichrist (Ludus de Antichristo) was composed around 1160 at the imperial Bavarian abbey of Tegernsee, at a critical point in the power-struggle between the papacy and Emperor Frederick Barbarossa. This new translation and commentary reveals this drama to be strikingly representative of the role that theatrical performance played in shaping contemporary politics, diplomacy, and public opinion. It also shows how drama functioned as an integral component of the educational curricula of elite monastic institutions like Tegernsee, where political administrators and diplomats were trained, and how performance served as a common, connective

Lords and Towns in Medieval Europe Howard B. Clarke,Anngret Simms.2017-07-14 This volume is based on possibly the biggest single Europe-wide project in urban history. In 1955 the International Commission for the History of Towns established the European historic towns atlas project in accordance with a common scheme in order to encourage comparative urban studies. Although advances in urban archaeology since the 1960s have highlighted the problematic relationship between the oldest extant town plan and the actual origins of a town, the large-scale cadastral maps as they have been made available by the European historic towns atlas project are

still necessary if we want to understand the evolution of the physical form of our towns. By 2014 the project consisted of over 500 individual publications from over 18 different countries across Europe. Each atlas comprises at least a core-map at the scale of 1:2500, analytical maps and an explanatory text. The time has come to use this enormous database that has been compiled over the last 40 years. This volume, itself based on a conference related to this topic that was held in the Royal Irish Academy in Dublin in 2006, takes up this challenge. The focus of the volume is on the question of how seigneurial power influenced the creation of towns in medieval Europe and of how this process in turn influenced urban form. Part I of the volume addresses two major issues: the history of the use of town plans in urban research and the methodological challenges of comparative urban history. Parts II and III constitute the core of the book focusing on the dynamic relationship between lordship and town planning in the core area of medieval Europe and on the periphery. In Part IV the symbolic meaning of town plans for medieval people is discussed. Part V consists of critical contributions by an archaeologist, an art historian and an historical geographer. By presenting case studies by leading researchers from different European countries, this volume combines findings that were hitherto not available in English. A comparison of the English and German bibliographies, attached to this volume, reveals some interesting insights as to how the focus of research shifted over time. The book also shows how work on urban topography integrates the approaches of the historian, archaeologist and historical geographer. The narrative of medieval urbanization becomes enriched and the volume is a genuine contribution to European studies.

A Companion to Medieval Vienna .2021-04-26 This volume provides a multidisciplinary view on the complexity of an emerging city, offering, for the first time in English, an overview of the current state of research on Vienna in the Middle Ages.

Disciplined Dissent Autori Vari.2017-01-03T00:00:00+01:00 Inspired by current debates around political confrontation and the exercise of power, Fabrizio Titone offers an interpretation based on the concept of disciplined dissent. This interpretation is centred on the notion of diffused power and is designed to transcend the binary distinction consensus/resistance. The aim is to identify the conservative process involved in mounting a critique, a protest, through which those who object may have intercepted and then deployed on their own account the cultural repertoire of those in a position of authority. This was with a view to obtaining a hearing, or even influencing the activities of the government and decentering the exercise of power. In order to ascertain how adaptable the latter is, the decision was taken to include studies relating to wholly distinct political contexts. Contributions by scholars from different backgrounds shed light upon different circumstances prevailing in continental and non-continental medieval Europe. The aim is to offer a broad spectrum of analyses on political confrontation, the formulation of critiques and the attainment of spaces for participation by means of non-violent protest.
