Rarely does a historian decide to open the door of his study and join in the melee about the meaning of history. More often he slams it shut and returns to his studies, oblivious of the fact that with the passage of time the gap between his scientific work and its audience might widen. The historian does not shun the battle, he merely chooses his own battleground.
